

3.25 Designating Class “B” Highway Ordinance Amended

The following statutes affect this form; s.349.15, Wis. stats.

State of Wisconsin
Town of Bridge Creek
Eau Claire County

The Town Board of the Town of Bridge Creek, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under 349.15 (2), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as class “B” highways in the town as follows:

- A. The following town highways in the Town of Bridge Creek are designated class “B” highways subject to the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. stats., unless increased by town ordinance:
Airport Road, Bartig Road, Brunzil Road, Dolotta Road, Faske Road, Gregor Road, Haskins Road, Hay Creek Road, Hiltz Road, Jack Pine Road, Karow Road (Co Road G to Kelly Road), Kelly Road, Lange Road, Livermore Road, Nehring Road, Oak Ridge Road, Pettis Road, Solie Road, Sperber Road, Stinson Road, Windmill Road, and Zank Road.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the weight limits set forth in s.348.16 (2), Wis. stats. Upon conviction for a violation of this ordinance, the violators shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$ 250.00 nor more than \$ 2,000.00, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective on June 1, 2025.

The town clerk shall properly post and publish this ordinance as required under s 60.80, Wis. stats.
